

THE CENTURION PROGRAM



This is a very easy way of getting into the habit of making a personal contribution to The Rotary Foundation. The commitment you are asked to make is simply contribute A\$100 per year as long as you are able to. In this case, the money is paid into The Australian Rotary Foundation Trust making your contribution tax deductible. **Members/Individuals** are the donors and will receive individual tax receipts)/ DGR status 1. The initial commitment is recognised by the presentation of the 'Centurion' lapel badge. Partners and friends of Rotarians are welcome to become Centurions, and their support will be most appreciated.

It is not a large commitment, but an important one in terms of our overall contribution to The Foundation. All Centurion contributions from Rotarians count towards their **Club's Annual Giving** total. It also contributes to **District 9675's** contribution to the Rotary Foundation resulting in 47.5% of the contribution coming back to the District to use as funding for District or Global Grants.
