THE AWARDS PROCESS

Women have been nominated through Rotary clubs and Districts, and by members of the community, and we have now **received 66 nominations**. A panel of independent judges will then assess nominees on three key criteria:

- Community service which best exemplifies Rotary's motto of *Service Above Self*
- Personal attributes
- Contribution to their organisation, community or cause which demonstrate inspirational characteristics, service and behaviours that provide reassurance and improves the quality of life in their community.

The Inspirational Women's Awards consist of Inspirational Woman of the Year (30+) and Young Inspirational Woman of the Year (18-30) in each of the categories

- Rural
- Volunteer
- General

Rotary Inspirational Woman of the Year Presentation Luncheon will be held on Sunday, 26th August 2018 at Epping Club, Epping.

- *Edei Ledet*, AG Sutherland Shire will be the Master of Ceremonies,

And two Inspirational Speakers:

- *Debra Wallace* – Detective Superintendent – Commander, Criminal Group and Strike Force Raptor
